QUALITY OF LIFE

- Building heights be capped at a maximum of three (3) stories, 42 feet
- Opposes any movement of the CCSL (City Coastal Construction Setback Line) for commercial, hospitality or any unspecified purpose
- Recommend staff initiate exploration of the establishment of a local historic district

TRAFFIC AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

- Sidewalks-
 - Complete sidewalk on west side of Peninsula Avenue, north to Florida Avenue.
 - Fill gaps to complete continuous sidewalk on Pine Street between Ocean Avenue and Crawford Road.
 - Fill gaps to complete continuous sidewalk on Cooper Avenue from Ocean Avenue to Lincoln Avenue.

- Create continuous designated bicycle route the entire length of the beachside from Smyrna Dunes Park to southern city limit.
- Traffic flow improvements at intersection of Pine Street and Jessamine Avenue.
- Designated routes for commercial vehicles servicing businesses in the Central Beach neighborhood.
- Make speed limit in residential neighborhoods uniform to 20mph
