

GOLF ADVISORY MEETING JANUARY 6, 2009

This is the report of the golf advisory meeting held on January 6, 2009 in the main dining room at the Golf course on Wayne Ave, New Smyrna Beach at 3.30 PM.

A roll call was held and all members of the Golf Advisory Board were present except Ed Winokur

City Manager John Hagood and Commissioner James Hathaway attended the meeting.

Chairman Lindley made a motion for approval of the minutes of the 12-9-2008 meeting. Ed Vaissiere made a MOTION the minutes be approved as written, It was seconded by Moe Pearce.

All present members voted for approval of the motion.

Marylyn Lindley told Paul Donoghue to send the new minutes report to Cindy Evans and she will send it to the commissioners. Paul Donoghue said the golf advisory board already addressed that subject and it was decided by the board that Paul Donoghue will send out the report directly to the city commission. Paul Donoghue also stated that the GAB reports have not been posted for seven months on the city web site.

Moe Pearce stated he did not have a financial report as there are some software problems. He is working with Althea Philord on the issue.

Marilyn Lindley said she is working on a welcome party for the new Golf Course Manager.

Marilyn Lindley requested that Paul Donoghue talk to Yogi McDonald, the new president of the MGA, to see if the MGA would be willing to give up a Saturday a month for Tournaments. Paul Donoghue agreed he would do that.

Commission Hathaway stated that the City Commission has not funded a marketing manager for the city. He stated the mayor is in favor of one being approved.

John Hagood said he has retained a person to market the condos for the golf course.

Paul Donoghue asked Celeste Stanwick how many condo groups have signed up to play golf at New Smyrna. She stated that no condo groups have signed up to play at New Smyrna..

Leo Kernica made a MOTION that the membership fees should be the same for residents and non residents. The MOTION was seconded by Ed Vaissiere. A vote was held and all present members voted for approval of the MOTION.

John Hagood stated he has made the decision on the new manager for the golf course and is doing background checks. He plans to present the person to the city commission for approval at the next commission meeting.

John Hagood plans to have a on-line system in place for reserving tee times.
