



37 **SECTION 5:** Qualifications of members. Wherever possible the  
38 City Commission shall appoint members to the Budget Task Force who  
39 have demonstrated expertise, training, education or experience in  
40 finance, accounting or business or related fields.

41 City officers and employees and members of other City advisory  
42 boards may not serve as members of the Budget Task Force.

43 **SECTION 6:** Duties. The Budget Task Force shall review and make  
44 recommendations to the City Manager regarding the development of  
45 the City's annual budget and capital improvements program and  
46 perform such other duties and assignments as requested by the City  
47 Manager.

48 **SECTION 7:** The Budget Task Force will meet at least once per  
49 month from April to September. The Budget Task Force shall elect  
50 a chair and a vice-chair. The Budget Task Force shall meet at such  
51 times and such places as requested by the City Manager after  
52 consultation with the Task Force, as may be necessary to accomplish  
53 the Task Force's duties.

54 A majority of the members of the Budget Task Force present at  
55 a meeting shall be necessary to make any determination required by  
56 the Task Force. Meetings shall be open to the public and minutes  
57 shall be kept. A public record of the Task Force's minutes shall  
58 be maintained and made available for inspection by the public.

59 **SECTION 8:** *Conflicting Resolutions.* That all resolutions or  
60 parts thereof that are in conflict with this resolution are hereby  
61 rescinded and repealed.

62 **SECTION 9:** *Effective Date.* That this resolution shall take  
63 effect immediately upon its adoption.

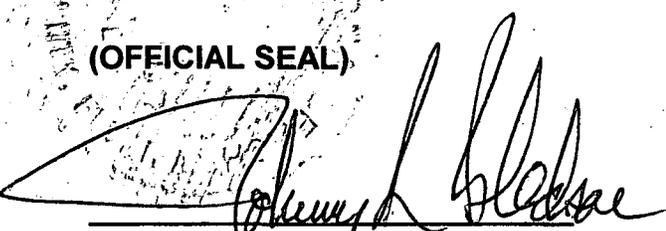
