Chapter 66 Solid Waste

Ordinance No. 63-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 89-06, SECTIONS 3 AND 4, TO REVISE USER CHARGES FOR THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE AND HOUSEHOLD TRASH, YARD TRASH, AND HOUSEHOLD RECEPTACLES; COMMERCIAL USER CHARGES FOR COLLECTION OF REFUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Understanding the increase:

- The City's residential and commercial customers have not had a rate increase in their solid waste fees since October 1, 2007.
- City's current solid waste provider, Waste Pro, has not received a rate increase since October 1, 2007. New five (5) year contract provides for no rate increases the first two years, but up to 3% rate increases in each of the last three years of the five-year term.
- Tipping fees paid directly by the City to the County of Volusia for the cost of disposal of household garbage, vegetative yard waste and bulk waste have increased from \$660,000 in 2011 to a projected amount of \$945,000 for the current budget year. Projections based on growth, voluntary annexations, and the current trend indicate that the cost of tipping fees could increase from \$945,000 annually to \$1,045,000 by FY 2021.
- The Solid Waste Fund Balance which is used to fund overages in tipping fees or other unanticipated costs such as debris removal during natural disasters such as Hurricane Matthew in October 2016 is currently projected at \$189,477. The cost of debris removal alone for Hurricane Matthew was just over \$3.0 million.
- The one-time 10% rate adjustment is the only increase to the amount customers pay for solid waste services proposed during the current five (5) year contract period with Waste Pro which runs through September 30, 2021.
