

CITY OF NEW SMYRNA BEACH PARKING and PASS INSTRUCTIONS

Beginning October 5, 2017, all new passes distributed are ELECTRONIC PASSES. Application is to be made online at parknsb.com and **no paper passes will be issued**. The vehicle tag number will be used for verification of your current permit. Once submitted, your parking pass will be approved within **5 business days** and you will be notified via email of approval. You may not utilize fee parking until this notification is received.

Applicable Parking Locations within New Smyrna Beach for use of the Parking Pass

- 27th Street Oceanfront Park
- Flagler Avenue Oceanfront Park
- Esther Street Oceanfront Park
- Grayce Barck North Beach Community Park
- Marianne Clancy Park

Hours of Operation

- 27th Street – Open 1 hour before sunrise; Closes at 11 PM
- Flagler Avenue Oceanfront Park – Open 1 hour before sunrise; Closes at 2:30 AM (next day)
- Esther Street Oceanfront Park – Open 1 hour before sunrise; Closes at 11 PM
- Grayce Barck North Beach Park – Open 1 hour before sunrise; Closes at 11 PM
- Marianne Clancy Park – Open 1 hour before sunrise; Closes at 11 PM

Vehicles are required to obtain a PARKING PASS or pay the daily rate of **\$20.00** as a fee for parking in the facilities listed above during the hours of 9 AM through 5 PM regardless of when the vehicle commenced parking.

Vehicles Allowed

Motor vehicles including passenger cars, trucks with a net weight of 7,500 pounds or less, and motorcycles may park in the designated areas.

Motor homes, recreational vehicle-type vehicles, trailers, trucks with a net weight in excess of 7,500 pounds, commercial motor vehicles, truck tractors and buses **are prohibited** at all times from parking in any of the facilities listed above.

Parking Pass

Volusia County residents may obtain an FREE PARKING PASS with proof of residency.

The **FREE NSB VOLUSIA RESIDENT PARKING PASS** is available to “Permit Holder(s)” who reside within the incorporated boundaries of Volusia County.

- A **Permit Holder** must reside within the boundaries of Volusia County and must provide a **valid driver’s license and proof of one of the following when making application:**
 - A. A current vehicle registration with a physical address within the County boundary
 - B. A vehicle registration in the name of a natural person who has a Volusia County Property Tax bill demonstrating ownership of residential property with an address within the County boundary
 - C. A vehicle registered in the name of a natural person with a current lease agreement of at least a 6 month term within the County boundary
 - D. A vehicle registered in the name of a natural person with at least the last Four (4) consecutive months’ utility bills for service of a residential address within the County boundary

- **Nonresident Applicants** and/or those without required proof of residency may purchase a NSB VOLUSIA COUNTY NON RESIDENT ANNUAL PARKING PASS for a \$100.00 fee each year. Nonresidents applying for an annual pass must present a current driver’s license and a current vehicle registration.

The following conditions **apply to all holders** of PARKING PASSES:

1. Resident documents will be required each time a PARKING PASS is replaced.
2. All parking citations must be paid prior to the purchase of a PARKING PASS.
3. If a new vehicle is obtained, your current vehicle is replaced, or the vehicle tag is replaced within the permit period, a replacement pass must be obtained. **Replacement passes are available online at no cost regardless of the reason for application.**
4. Parking is on a first-come first-serve basis. The PARKING PASS does not guarantee that there will always be a parking space available and does not give the bearer preference or entrance to the lots. Parking spaces may not be reserved and violations may result in the confiscation of your pass.
5. Parking fees are not refundable. If for any reason an PARKING PASS holder pays to park in any of the 5 locations, the parking fee will not be refunded.
6. The PARKING PASS is valid only for the 5 Parking Locations listed above and may not be used to meet parking fee requirements for any other sites.

NOTE: If you have a current New Smyrna Beach Parking Permit for your vehicle as a resident of Volusia County, you do NOT need a separate Boat Ramp Permit to park at one of the three city boat ramps (North Causeway Boat Ramp – West Side, North Causeway Boat Ramp – East Side and Swoope Boat Ramp/US 1).

The PARKING PASS is intended for individual use only and is not for resale, or commercial, industrial or business use. Residents may not transfer ownership of their pass with the sale or lease of their home or vehicle. A NSB VOLUSIA RESIDENT PARKING PASS shall not be resold or assigned for profit. Abuse and misuse of any pass will result in the confiscation of the permit and denial of any future passes.

7. PARKING PASS fees (if non-resident or lacking valid documentation) are due at the time of purchase. A non-resident parking pass is valid for one (1) calendar year and will be prorated bi-annually. All passes purchased from January 1st through June 30th will be charged 100% of the fee. Passes purchased from July 1st through December 31st will be charged 50% of the fee. The annual fee for a parking pass is \$100.00.
8. A vehicle displaying a disabled parking permit or license plate in accordance with Section 316.1984, Florida Statutes, is exempt from the parking fee but is subject to the Hours of Operation.
9. If a check payment is refunded or a charge back on a credit card is received the PARKING PASS will be considered VOID and a \$25.00 return check fee will be assessed.
10. Parking citations will be issued if warranted without exception for any violation of these instructions or for any violation of City Parking Ordinances and local or state laws. Citations will not be voided.
11. The City has the full and sole discretion to revoke a Parking Pass or not to renew a PASS. The City reserves the right to pursue any and all legal remedies for any infractions of these instructions.
12. The terms, conditions and restrictions described above are subject to change and the City of New Smyrna Beach reserves the right to discontinue this program at any time. The PARKING PASS fees are subject to change annually or when the City Commission approves changes.
