

RECREATION AND PARKS FACILITIES

BEACHSIDE:

- 1. North Beach Community Park:** Located on the corner of Sapphire and Peninsula and continues to the corner of Sapphire and Atlantic, continuing down to the beach. There are 2 parking lots. It also has 2 gazebos located in the dunes and is accessible by wood walkways.
- 2. Coronado Civic Center:** Located at the corner of Flagler and Pine Street. The facility is home to the Coronado Shuffleboard Club with 20 courts; 8 of which are lighted for club play. The Civic Center recreation building includes a dining room, kitchen, and dance hall.
- 3. Flagler Avenue Boardwalk:** This is an oceanfront park is located on Flagler Avenue in the central beach area. This park is a joint effort with the County of Volusia and the City of New Smyrna Beach. This Park offers ample parking as well as showers and restrooms.
- 4. Detwiler Park:** Located at Oakwood Avenue and Horton Street midway between Flagler Avenue and 3rd Avenue in the central beachside area. Park facilities include 5 lighted tennis courts (no reservations required), lighted basketball court, restroom facilities, and a children's playground.
- 5. Callalisa Park:** Located along the South Causeway on Callalisa Creek, this park is mostly popular on the weekends. Fishing and picnicking are available.
- 6. Twenty-seventh Avenue:** This is an oceanfront park is located on A1A on the south beach. This park is a joint effort with the County of Volusia and the City of New Smyrna Beach. It includes 2 lit 3-wall & 1 4-wall racquetball courts. There is a basketball court, playground, restrooms and several covered pavilions. It also has beach access.
- 7. Indian River Lagoon Preserve:** Located at 663 Sandpiper, off South Saxon Dr., 190 plus/minus acres is hammock land filled with native vegetation. There are 2 acres that are developed and include limited parking, restrooms, covered pavilion and walking trails to a dock on Brown's Bay. There is also a smaller dock off Saxon Drive,

MAINLAND:

- 8. Brannon Community Center:** This facility is located at 105 South Riverside. The facility is the home of the senior center and the community center. The facility is available for rental.
- 9. Emory L. Bennett Park:** Located in the downtown district on Sams Avenue, this small park is convenient for passers-by to sit and enjoy the shade of a beautiful oak tree.
- 10. Riverside Park:** This beautiful eight acre park is located on the Indian River at the east end of Route 44 in the downtown area. The park includes walking paths, restroom facilities, and the **Manatee All Children's Playground**. The outdoor gazebo is located here and fishing is popular along the boardwalk and fishing pier. The park is the site of many community events including art festivals and the summer concert series. The playground is designed for enjoyment of all children and features swings, slides, mazes, and much more. The playground is handicap accessible.
- 11. Buena Vista Park:** Fishing and picnicking are popular in this newly renovated park on the west side of the Indian River on the North Causeway. A restroom and small playground are available.
- 12. Christmas Park:** This small but scenic park is located on the corner of Canal and Live Oak Streets. It features a small stage where concerts can be held here.
- 14. Turnbull Street Park:** This is a neighborhood park and used mostly by local youths. It has a small playground.

15. Mainland Shuffleboard Club: Mainland Clubhouse, which can house small meetings.

16. Skate Park: The newly opened NSB Skate Park is located at the southwest corner of Turnbull Street and Industrial Park Avenue, just west of the New Smyrna Beach Police Station. The new Skate Park has approximately 8,500 square feet of concrete skate area, consisting of a flow/street area and a pool with tile and concrete pool coping. The City of NSB assisted by NSB Skate committee members, obtained an ECHO Grant through Volusia County to aid in the construction of the park. Additionally, the City obtained a grant from the Tony Hawk Foundation. There is no charge to utilize the park. Hours of operation are (Monday-Friday) 12:00PM - Dusk (Weekends and Holidays) 10:00AM - Dusk. .

17. North Causeway Boat Ramp: This facility is located on the North Causeway and features docking facilities, fishing pier, a picnic pavilion, playground, and restroom facilities.

18. Old Fort Park: The historic Turnbull Ruins are located in this park along with the historic New Smyrna Beach Free Library. This park is located along Riverside Drive across Sams Avenue from City Hall. Several paths and benches are scattered under a beautiful canopy of oak trees. This is the site of

19. Women's Club: This facility is located at 403 Magnolia Street at the South Causeway overpass. The building features a kitchen, stage, and clubroom.

20. Recreation Department Office & City Gym: Located at 1000 Live Oak Street, this facility provides a gymnasium and is the Parks & Recreation Department Office – where all registrations for activities are taken.

21. Dog Park: The dog park is located on Paige Avenue behind the Humane Society. It is 1 ½ acre fenced in park for dogs and a shaded area for owners.

WESTSIDE:

- 22. Myrtle Avenue Park:** A shaded picnic area is the highlight of this park on West Canal Street. The beautiful azaleas bloom during springtime adding a delightful dash of color to the park.
- 23. Babe James Community Center:** Located at 201 North Myrtle Avenue, this facility is equipped with a game room for ping-pong, pool, air hockey and a variety of activities, and a gymnasium. The building is available for all ages and is also available for limited rentals.

24. Pettis Park: This four-acre park is located on Mary Avenue and Duss Street, and includes two lighted tennis courts, two basketball courts, a multi-purpose field, playground, and restroom facilities.

25. Mary Street Park: This park features a children's playground set under the shadow of a large oak tree.

NORTHSIDE:

26. Rocco Park: This neighborhood park offers picnic facilities, tennis and basketball courts, a playground, and a fishing pier on Turnbull Bay. It is located on Sunset Dr. just south of South St.

27. Sports Complex: This 68 Acre Park is located on Sunset Drive just off Turnbull Bay Road. It features a football stadium which is home of the New Smyrna Beach High School Barracuda football and baseball teams, 3 lighted softball fields, 3 lighted soccer fields, 2 lighted multi-purpose fields, 4 lighted little league fields, and 1 lighted baseball field.

28. Inlet Shores Park: This small neighborhood park is located on Cunningham Drive and provides a basketball court and small playground.

29. Scout Hut: Located on Sunset Drive north of the Municipal Stadium, this facility has a meeting room, outdoor grill, and plenty of space for scouting groups to utilize for various functions.
