#### **ORDINANCE NO. 49-16**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BUDGET ORDINANCES NOS. 82-15, 100-15, 112-15, 114-15, 10-16, 17-16, 25-16, 30-16, 34-16, AND 42-16, CURRENT EXPENSES AND CAPITAL OUTLAY REQUIRED FOR 2015-2016; PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF UNENCUMBERED FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Althea Philord, Finance Director, has requested an amendment to Ordinance No. 82-15, Ordinance No. 100-15, Ordinance No. 112-15, Ordinance No. 114-15, Ordinance No. 10-16, Ordinance No. 17-16, Ordinance No. 25-16, Ordinance No. 30-16, Ordinance No. 34-16, and Ordinance No. 42-16, Current Expenses and Capital Outlay for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2015, and ending September 30, 2016, to set forth anticipated sources of revenues and estimated appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of New Smyrna Beach, Florida, deems that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of New Smyrna Beach to amend the City's 2015-2016 Fiscal Year Budget as more particularly set forth hereinafter.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NEW SMYRNA BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

193	parts thereof that are in conflict with this ordinance shall be and
194	the same are hereby rescinded and repealed.
