

Recycling Guidelines

Please have recycle bins curbside by 7AM on your collection day

Limit of (3) bins per household

Service includes one (1) weekly collection of recyclable material placed in City approved bins and carts and designated for recycling purposes

Single-Stream Recycling

Residents can place all recyclable items in bins for collection. This includes:

All paper products including newspaper, office paper, cardboard, telephone books, junk mail, magazines & paper bags

Aluminum & steel cans

Glass bottles (clear, green & amber)

Plastic bottles with recycle symbols
1-7

Newspapers (plastic sleeves removed)

Junk mail & magazines

Phone books & mixed office paper

Allowable Recyclable Materials

- All newspapers including inserts
- Glass bottles/jars including clear, green & brown with and without labels
- Aluminum, steel and steel/tins cans with or without labels
- Plastics including polyethylene terephthalate (PET) & high density polyethylene (HDPE) bottles
 - Phone books, junk mail, postcards, flyers & magazines
- Corrugated or thin cardboard (flattened)
- Plastic containers with recycle symbol 1 through 7

Recycling Facts

A ton of recycled paper saves:

17 trees, 380 gallons of oil, 3 cubic yards of landfill space, 4200 kilowatts of energy & 7,000 gallons of water

It requires 95% less energy and water to recycle an aluminum can than it does to create a new can from virgin material

5 recycled plastic bottles provide enough material to create one square foot of new carpet

Please do not place any of these items in your recycle bin or cart:

Window pane glass or ceramics

Any liquids including oil, chemicals, solvents or food products

No electronics or appliances

Automotive parts
